Children's Activities

Preschool children went on an adventure nature walk around the school field. Before they went they discussed what they might see that gave them a clue autumn was here, an abundance of knowledge came forward from the children about fallen leaves, their idea of the colours of autumn, nuts, seeds, berries, conkers and acorns.

Armed with clear plastic buckets they set off to collect anything autumnal they could use back in the nursery to create an autumn collage.

The children were keen to find special treasures for their creative collages and an amazing collection of leaves, conkers, acorns and feathers filled their buckets.









The children have been hugely interested in dinosaurs and have adored playing with them, sharing their knowledge and making up some super role-play scenarios with them. We were amazed with the facts they already know and we are excited to build on this knowledge

All children across the nursey have been focussing on a wide range of nursery rhymes as they are a powerful learning tool in your child's early literacy development and they enable children to become interested in the rhythms and patterns of language. We hope you have fun singing lots of nursery rhymes at home as well!

We are very keen to promote independence in our children and we would be grateful if your child could be dressed in clothes that allow them to access the toilets independently e.g. elasticated jogging bottoms. Please could you ensure that your child wears shoes which they can fasten themselves and that they can put their own coat on. We spend a lot of time outdoors, so a waterproof coat and a pair of wellies are essential. A clean change of clothing is also advisable for <u>all</u> children as accidents can happen. We would welcome any spare jogging bottoms as our stocks don't always make their way back to us and we are running low!

Breakfast and after school Clubs

As of Monday 10th October the children who are currently in Year one will be moving across to The Raft building for both breakfast and after school club. We have had children leave or cancel their current booking which has allowed us to move the year one children across to The Raft along with parental requests. The Raft will now be operating a waiting list for both breakfast and after school club on certain days so adhoc spaces are now very limited. All school children will attend the Raft during the school holidays.

Packed Lunch – For children who do not eat a hot nursery lunch, the option of bringing in a packed lunch is available. When choosing items for your child's lunch box please be mindful of our Nutrition Policy which requests that parents support us in our healthy eating aims when providing packed lunches. Food such as crisps, chocolate, sweets or fizzy drinks should be avoided, as should any other foods with high levels of additives/colourings as some children are highly sensitive to these ingredients which can severely affect their behaviour and /or make them sick. Food with **nut** content should also be avoided as children with severe allergy to nuts can suffer extreme reactions even via indirect contact. Fruit or vegetable and dairy snacks are encouraged,
